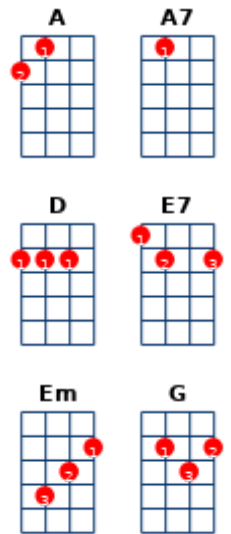
Away In A Manger
